One of the most important things to do as a Christian parent is to teach your children to love and study God's word. And that begins with a child learning to read. Reading is key to a child's development and growth. This is why we plan to make reading a priority from May 2-15, 2021 during our first ever LCS Read-A-Thon!

The purpose of this fundraiser is to raise money for new books and resources in both the library and classrooms. We are asking each student to find sponsors as they strive to reach our school-wide goal of 50,000 minutes of reading! Raising around \$3500 will provide us with plenty of brand new reading materials for all grades.

I will be emailing you three forms today:

1. Sponsor Form - This form should be printed off (one for each child) and used to collect the sponsorship money. We encourage you to make a plan to ensure you are safely collecting money. 2. Minute Tracker - This form is for you as parents to keep track of how many minutes your child is reading each day. Then you can use this tracker to enter the minutes to the online form. (This tracking form is optional and does not need to be handed in. It is for organizational purposes only). 3. Online Check-In Form - This Google Form is where you will enter all of your child's reading minutes. You will enter the number of minutes they have read since your last check in.

Here is the breakdown of how many minutes, per grade, each child should be reading to reach our goal: JK-SK = 15 mins/day, Grades 1-3 = 25 mins/day, Grades 4-8 & Staff = 30 mins/day.

We can't wait to see your child(ren)'s love for reading grow during the Read-A-Thon! Someone once said "Children are made readers on the laps of their parents." We encourage you to spend these upcoming weeks reading with and alongside your child(ren). Let's inspire young readers by our example!

This week, in our new printing workbooks, please complete pages 6/7 (letters w and t) and pages 8/9 (letters a and d).

This week, we will match upper and lowercase letters, listen for short vowel sounds in words and count the number of syllables per word. Our new **sight word** is "come".

In **math**, we will do some measuring using items we have in our home. We continue to learn to count groups of 10 by 10.

For **science**, we will learn that when we hear sound, energy is being used. What sounds do you hear around your house?

Our **listening story** this week is an English folktale about The Sun and The Wind.

Our **daily zoom meeting** is from 10:00- 12:00. Students receive an email with the link each morning.


In **Bible**, we are completing our Bible unit entitled "Growing Popularity" with a review today and a test tomorrow
