Junior Kindergarten- Mrs. Baarda:

JK will be busy this week finishing up projects and practicing for the Christmas program. We will practice getting on and off the stage and practice our song and verse on the stage. We will try to fit in some learning as well!

In **language**, we will continue to practice rhyming, syllables, and word counting. We will read some more Christmas stories.

In Math, we will build some patterns using blocks.

Tuesday is a **Christmas dress up day**. Students can wear Christmas sweaters, any other Christmas clothing, or they can wear Christmas colours.

For the Christmas program on Thursday:

JK will be performing at the beginning of both the afternoon and evening programs. In the afternoon, we will return to the classroom after our part of the program is finished. In the evening, JKs will wait at the front after we perform while the SK class does their part and then parents will be asked to come and retrieve their children so they can spend the rest of the performance with you. **Please have your child in the classroom by 6:40 on Thursday evening**. Please make sure students have used the washroom before they come.

Senior Kindergarten- Mrs. Heida:

This week we are focusing on the sound of the letter Dd. It is considered a STOP sound as we say it quickly without the "uh" at the end. Everyday we rhyme words and listen for the number of sounds in each word and then print those letter sounds. The students were introduced to the sight words "is" and "as" last week. In **Math**, we will learn how to create a pattern and label a pattern using letters of the alphabet.

In Bible, we will wrap up our Christmas unit with a visit from the Wise Men.

The Christmas program will happen on Thursday at 1pm and 7pm. At the 1pm performance, SK will leave the gym after their stage time and will go to the classroom to play. At the 7pm performance, I ask that all students meet me in the classroom around 6:40pm. Please put all their coats on their hooks, the classroom will be locked after we leave to go to the gym. Once we are done with our part, the SK students will sit with their parents. Please come to the front to get them.

On Friday, we will come to school to enjoy a singing assembly at 9:30 am and then at 1:30 we will head to the arena to go skating. We will arrive with Grade 1 on the first bus and will have to leave the ice by 2:30pm.We go back to the school on the first bus which will give us time to have a quick easy snack, a drink, and a bathroom break. Please label the skates, helmets and gloves and put them in a separate bag from their backpack. Since we have to travel and get on and off the ice at different times, please send skates with the SK child so that we don't have to wait for an older sibling to arrive.

This year the **Christmas program** is on a Thursday night and then SK is back at school on Friday. They will be very tired. I am asking for parents to meet us at the arena to help tie skates and assist with the younger students. I would appreciate any extra hands. If you are picking them up afterschool, please know that all pickups will happen at LCS. Please inform the office.

Math - We have finished our unit on multiplication and will have a quiz on WEDNESDAY. Students will need to know their facts up to 12, how to estimate, complete 2-digit by 1-digit multiplication and answer word problems. Grade 5s will also need to know how to complete 2-digit by 2-digit multiplication. Smartboard notes will be sent home on Tuesday night to help students prepare for the quiz.

We will watch "The Grinch" together and celebrate all the students' hard work learning their multiplication tables!
